



## 2019 Lafayette GO Trip



**When:** Friday, June 21 – Monday, June 24, 2019

**Who:** Individuals of all ages and families, seeking to make an impact for Jesus

Team members must demonstrate:

- Faith in Christ
- A desire to see what God is doing in the Lincoln community through Faith Church in Lafayette, IN
- A heart to serve others
- A willingness to invest in the community through projects and outreach
- Adequate physical health – there will be some walking and physical activity involved
- Flexibility and good attitude – plans can change often

**What/Where:**

An opportunity to minister alongside individuals from Faith Church in Lafayette, and those living in the Lincoln community (Hartford Hub area), to help with neighborhood/community revitalization through clean-up, landscape and home repair projects, and build relationships through a neighborhood block party and shared time together

**Requirements:**

- Fill out an online application at [bethelweb.org/gotrips](http://bethelweb.org/gotrips). Families going on the trip may make one payment for the entire family. Everyone 13 and older must fill out an online application. Those under 13 do not need to fill out an online application.
- Attend orientation meeting on May 19 and training meeting on June 9. These dates are subject to change based on unforeseen circumstances.

**Cost:** \$100/person - includes lodging, meals, and materials

**Raising Support:** Do not let financial cost deter you from going! There are ways to raise support that will be discussed at the first meeting. Moreover, we believe greatly in the power of prayer, so each team member is also required to ask others to be their prayer supporters for the trip, which entails committing to regularly pray for the individual and the team. We have support letter/email templates you can use if desired. In addition to asking for prayer, you are also free to use this same template to ask for financial support for the trip.

**Responsibility of Team Members:**

- 1) Use the trip to grow in your relationship with Jesus Christ.
- 2) Learn how to develop life-impacting relationships with those who don't know Christ.
- 3) Listen to the prayer needs of the ministry partner. Pray that God burdens your heart to pray more fervently for those who don't know Jesus.
- 4) Be a servant to the other participants on your team and the staff, in order that your brief stay might serve as a long-term encouragement to the work.
- 5) Be respectful of the local church. Absolutely no use of drugs, alcoholic beverages, or tobacco.

**Online application form and \$100/pp due on May 5, 2019.**

**Payment Deadlines:**

- All payments are non-refundable except for extreme extenuating circumstances. Another exception to this would be any instance where an applicant is not accepted for the GO Trip. Their deposit will be promptly refunded.
